#### **Monthly Board Meeting Notes – January 10, 2009**

President John Ward called the meeting to order at approximately 8:30 AM at the Eagles Nest Clubhouse.

#### Meeting Attendees:

#### Agenda items discussed were as follows:

- ? The Minutes published for the previous December 6 meeting were voted on and approved.
- ? Bruce Hulbert, our Treasurer, passed out copies of the PCM9GA Year End Financial Report which showed a snapshot balance at \$7,011.55. Likewise, the actual balance as of January 9 was listed as \$5,281.55 with details as follows:

Beginning January 1, 2009 Balance	\$7,011.55
Dues Collection	\$280.00
Annual AGA Fees for 126 Members	(1,890.00)
January 15 Tournament Expenses	(120.00)
Net Balance as of January 9	\$5,281.55

- ? Randy James reviewed the structure of the forthcoming January 15 tournament in great detail regarding the Best Ball system where each player would play out their own ball and both their gross score and net score, (based upon their prevailing handicap) would be compiled. Each 4 foursome would be required to use at least 2 scores from each player and for three-somes, 3 scores from each player. Depending upon the individual players' handicap, anywhere from 0 strokes to two or more strokes would be subtracted from the gross score. A document, entitled "A Note to All Team Captains" was passed out and reviewed at the meeting and discussed in some detail, which described rules which all PCM9GA Members should pay much closer attention to for both tournament play as well as regular weekly play. Basic topics of this document covered the following and the intention was to pass these rules out to all Team Captains and attach them to each score card:
  - o OFF THE TEE
  - o OFF THE FAIRWAY
  - o BALL HIT INTO ROUGH OR TRANSITIONAL (SAND AND DIRT)
  - o DO NOT IMPROVE YOUR LIE



- ? Bob Bloomquist discussed formalizing plans for the forthcoming Charity Tournament to be jointly held for both PCM9GA and PCW9GA members in some detail, indicating he was working closely with Wally Campbell and Charlotte Krause. Bob indicated they were jointly considering a number of worthy local charities. At the time of the meeting on January 10, only the date of March 17, St. Patrick's had been firmed up since but subsequently, Bob Bloomquist issued a memo documenting tremendous progress that had been made regarding details of this forthcoming Charity Tournament. Bob Bloomquist will fully go over all the details of his meeting and agreements jointly with Charlotte Krause but the bottom line will be as follows:
- o 144 players
  - o Total Income including player fees, cash raffles. Buy a putt, buy a mulligan and closest to the hole will generate \$2,808
  - o Total expected expenses will be \$1,334
  - o Net Available for Donation will be \$1,474

According to Bob Bloomquist, the PCW9GA suggested the donation to be made to the Mobile Elementary School and Bob Bloomquist will detail this in the forthcoming February 7 meeting. Also discussed was the solicitation of gift certificates as prizes for the forthcoming March 17 tournament from local restaurants such as Macaronis Grill, possibly Olive Garden and PF Chaings but no specific assignments were made as to implementing this plan.

- ? Since the March 17 joint PCM9GA and PCW9GA Tournament will occur on Tuesday, March 17, it was decided that the normally to be scheduled monthly regular PCM9GA Tournament on Thursday, March 19 will be just an ordinary biweekly PCM9GA outing.
- ? An announcement was made encouraging PCM9GA members to attending the next scheduled Newcomers meeting on January 19<sup>th</sup> at the Chianti Room to afford the opportunity to introduce new prospective members to PCM9GA.
