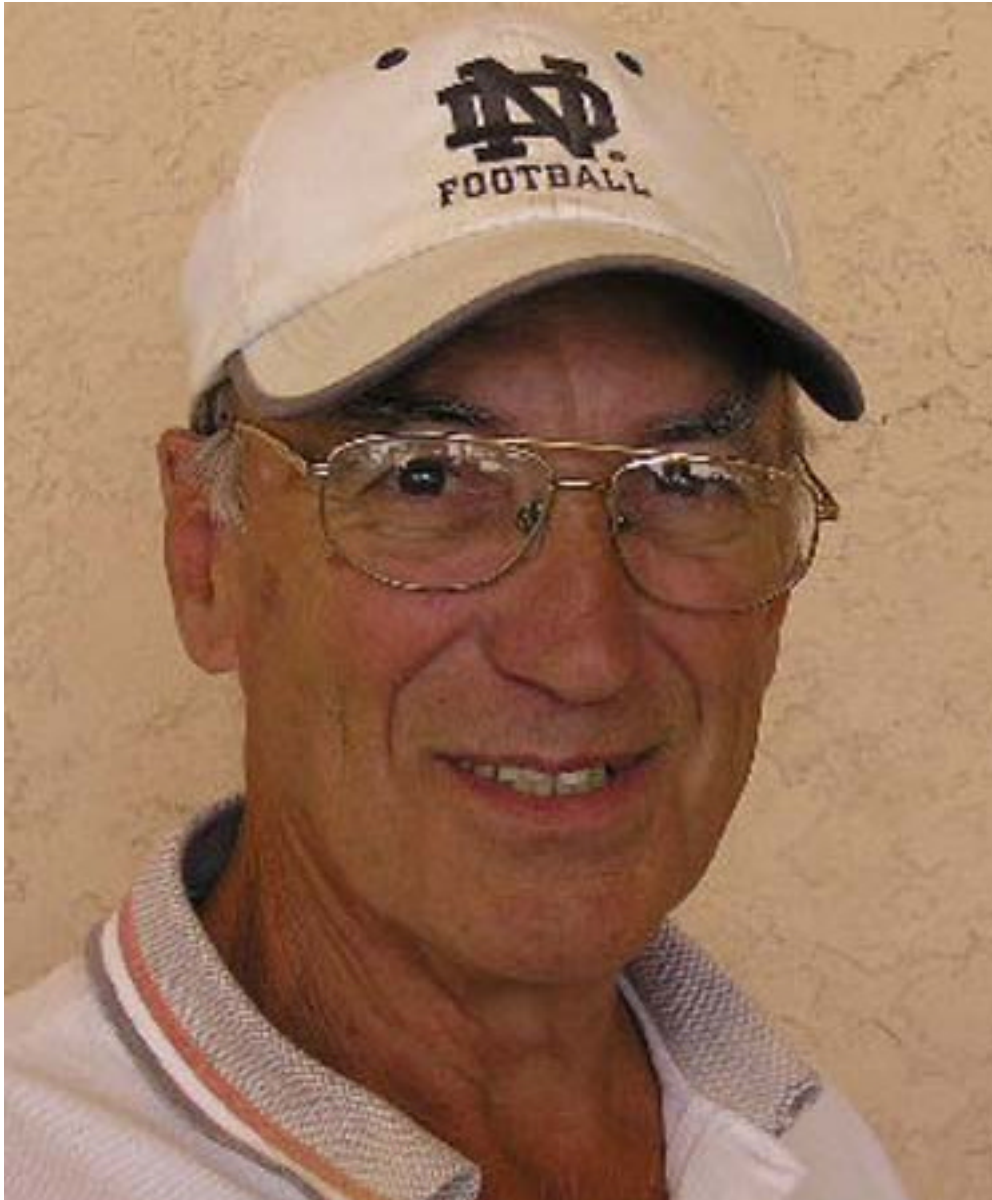


Jim Sullivan
